

Understanding Vector vs. Raster


Vector artwork contains shapes and lines made from mathematical calculations that can be scaled with no loss to quality because the math formulas stay the same. In addition, vector artwork can easily be changed to have limited colors which is required by processes such as screen printing, embroidery, “stencil-cut” vinyl, and promotional items (logos printed on cups, pens, etc.)

Raster artwork is made of pixels that cannot be scaled up without causing a blurry image due to a fixed number of pixels saved into the image.
